

## **NOTICE of Construction Start-Up**

McIntosh Perry would like to notify residents and business owners that work has started on the reconstruction of the existing Kingston Ferry Dock on Barrack Street.

### **Construction Timeline:**

- Construction began on Wednesday, September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2020. Preparation has included placing signage, arranging the project layout, and surveying the construction area.
- Wolfe Island Ferry Service will not be impacted by the construction and will continue to run throughout the anticipated construction timeline.
- Please note that due to the need to accommodate the larger ferry dock construction, the parking lot located at the east end of the dock was closed permanently on Wednesday, September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2020.
- Construction activities will continue throughout the whole year, with a completion date of December 2023.

Periodic lane closures can be expected on Ontario Street throughout construction along with construction vehicles entering and exiting the work zone. Vehicles and pedestrians are asked to follow traffic control signage when approaching the construction zone. All consideration has been given to implement traffic control measures to ensure minimal disruption to the traveling public. We apologize in advance for this inconvenience and very much appreciate the public's patience during construction.
