Dear Wolfe Island Ferry Passengers,

Please be advised McIntosh Perry is the organization responsible for construction management of the Wolfe Island Ferry Projects acting on behalf of the Ministry of Transportation.

This notice is to advise passengers that construction of the Kingston Wolfe Island Ferry dock is expected to commence this week. Coco Paving Ltd. is the Ministry of Transportation's Contractor responsible for this portion of work.

To facilitate construction of the new dock and enhanced ferry facility, the parking lot located at the end of the existing pier will be closed permanently as of **Wednesday, September 23rd, 2020**. This parking area will not be reopening as part of the completed dock due to the larger ferry and increased area required for boarding vehicles.

Passengers currently using the existing parking lot are required to make alternate parking arrangements and ensure their vehicle is moved **prior to September 23rd**, when construction begins.
